MIP Continues Its Social Responsibility Projects

Mersin International Port Management Inc. (MIP) has signed a protocol with Mersin Governorate and the Provincial Directorate of National Education for two important initiatives, namely the "Yenişehir Mersin International Port Elementary School" and the "Aziz Sancar Sports Facility Renovation".

As part of MIP's social responsibility projects, aiming to make a positive impact on society and taking significant steps in education and sports, the protocol for the second school project, "Construction of a 24-Classroom Elementary School and Environmental Arrangements in Menteş Neighborhood, Yenişehir District," and the "Aziz Sancar Sports Facility Renovation" projects were recently signed between Mersin Governorate, MIP, and the Provincial Directorate of National Education. The school will be named "Yenişehir Mersin International Port Elementary School" and will be handed over to the Ministry of National Education upon completion of construction and environmental arrangements.

Another significant project by MIP is the "Aziz Sancar Sports Facility Renovation," aims to promote sports among young people and provide Mersin with enhanced sports facilities. MIP will meticulously carry out the renovation works, ensuring the modern completion of the sports facility.

During his speech at the signing ceremony, MIP General Manager Ajay Kumar Singh emphasized their commitment to increasing their contributions to Mersin. He expressed gratitude to all project partners, especially the Governor and Deputy Governor, saying, "We are proud to undertake the construction of a 24-classroom elementary school and the renovation of a sports facility, aiming to enhance sports opportunities in our beautiful city of Mersin. As MIP, our goal is to focus on education, sports and cultural projects that will contribute to the quality of life of our society, in line with our mission of adding value to Mersin. The signing ceremony of the protocol, coordinated by Mersin Governorate, marks the first step in our initiatives for Yenişehir Mersin International Port Elementary School and Aziz Sancar Sports Facility Renovation. These projects are just the beginning of our efforts this year. Moving forward, we will continue to support education in Mersin, aiming to meet the educational needs of children in the region.
