Subject: Regarding Occupational Safety Announcement

Dear Business Partners,

Within the scope of updates on occupational safety measures, all port users who may be present for any purposes in all facilities and areas within the boundaries of the Mersin International Port are required to comply with the rules to make the working environment safer.

1. It is compulsory to use personal protective equipment (PPE), minimally including a safety helmet, safety shoes, and high-visibility fluorescent reflective safety vest for all port users and visitors, that complies with the requirements listed below in case of entering the port from all Gate on foot or in a vehicle:
 - **Safety Helmet:** The name-surname and blood type of the person who will be entering the port area with the representative company/institution's name should be written on head-protective safety helmets
 - **Fluorescent Safety Vest:** The name of the company/institution and contact information of the company's authorized person name and contact information should be placed on high-visibility and preferably light blue colored fluorescent reflective safety vest
 - **Safety Shoes:** Safety shoes should be steel-toe protective footwear with slip-resistant soles

Otherwise, entrance to the port without proper personal protective equipment (PPE) shall not be allowed. In case any of the personal protective equipment listed above is missing, the person/vehicle and/or driver shall not enter to the port area, as of **01.11.2022**.

2. As of 01.11.2022, it will be stipulated that a medium-sized flashing strobe light should be mounted on top of the vehicles which will enter the port area from all Gates between around the clock to increase the visibility of the vehicles traveling inside the port by operators of the port equipment and to improve occupational safety. In case of the cars/vehicles do not meet this requirement, they shall not be allowed to enter port area.
3. As of 01.01.2023, for permanent or daily port entry applications, it will be compulsory to complete occupational safety training successfully. Training content is accessible at <https://mipisg.mersinport.com.tr/>. Moreover, all port users are expected to submit their screen shots of successful exam results to Card Desk during their port entry application, but drivers will be provided with safety induction training at MIP premises under MIP safety team supervision.
