Subject: MIP Terminal Operating System (TOS) Change 01.03.2024

Dear Valued Business Partners,

MIP is set to upgrade our current Terminal Operating System (TOS), to enhance the services we provide to our valued customers.

The transition to the new system will start on Saturday, 09 March 2024 at 18:00 and is scheduled for completion on Sunday, 10 March 2024.

Please be advised that during this transition period, all systems, including the Port Portal System (PPS) as well as the integration with the Customs system, will be temporarily unavailable. Consequently, MIP operations will be suspended from 18:00 on Saturday, 9 March 2024, until 23:59 on Sunday, 10 March 2024.

The operational process and details of the transition to our new terminal operation system GTOS are explained below.

4	Saturday 9 Mar 2024 20:00	All vessel operations will be suspended
5	Saturday 9 Mar 2024 23:00	Port Portal System (PPS) will be deactivated
6	Saturday 9 Mar 2024 23:59	All Gate-out activities will be stopped in MIP and external yards
