Dear Valued Business Partners,

As MIP, a buffer area has been created in our external yard until further notice for laden export containers in order to promote the ease of doing business and to prevent the disruption of the export transactions of our valued customers. Application will be started as of 16.12.2024 08:00 and the scope of the application will be as follows.

- Our storage yard is the non-custom bonded external yard called Terminal 7 and will be available 24/7.
- Reefer, IMDG and OOG containers will be taken to MIP port area as in our current practice.
- Export laden containers will be taken to the port area for vessels with gate status open in accordance with the ETB gate opening rule, and to Terminal 7 until 3 days before the gate opening date for vessels unless gate status open. (Example: Containers with gate status open according to ETB - 4 rule will be directed to port area, containers between ETB - 5 to 7 days will be directed to Terminal 7).
- For export laden containers to be delivered to Terminal 7, it is necessary to make an appointment via vehicle reservation system (VBS) and for containers delivered to Terminal 7 daily appointment quota will not be applied.
- MIP Price List and Specific Conditions will be valid for export containers taken to Terminal 7 as of the day they are taken to the yard.
- The containers to be taken to the Terminal 7 area will be transported to the port area under the responsibility of MIP according to MIP gate opening rules, and the relevant customs brokers will be informed and required to initiate customs procedures immediately for containers entering the port.
