Subject : Seal Check in Gates

Reference : Announcement No. MIP-0551-160-14/81 dated 14.01.2013

With the commissioning of new gates, article 2, article 3 and article 4 mentioned in annex 1 of referenced announcement “Export/Transit Containers” which is related to seal check procedures have been revised as below.

2. Seals which are provided by shipping agencies will be applied to containers which are stuffed inside the port or external yards by MIP personnel under custody of shipper or customs broker of shipper. Then, seal number will be saved to system by hand terminals.

3. Physical existence of seals will be checked for laden containers which are aimed to gate in, laden container without seal will not be accepted to port.

4. Containers with seals on, which are gated in through land or railway will be dispatched to stack or inspection yard upon Customs Authority’s decision.
