Within the context of SOLAS VGM Data Control and Provision Application; to accelerate the process and to eliminate difficulties, updates that are stated below will be applied as of **01.09.2016**.

VGM data update will be permitted until the final loading list for the containers arriving the terminal premises with VGM data in gate-in list. "Weighing Report" on MIP official website will not return weighing result, "Agent declared VGM Data" message will be shown.

For the containers that has been declared VGM during the gate-in, customers who want to receive an additional weighing result will be able to apply by submitting the "VGM Weighbridge Ticket" obtained to the related weighbridge operator.

"VGM Weighbridge Ticket" is 20 USD + VAT and could be used once per container and could be obtained from MIP Billing-Receivable Management.

Produced VGM Data of containers, arrived without VGM Data and stuffed in terminal premises will be available on our website for queries, until 4 calender days after the departure of the loading vessel. Previous application will continue and fees will be invoiced to the related parties as per the previous announcement accordingly.
