"New Wine in Old Bottles" social responsibility project has been realized by MIP and TIKAV. Education within this project was realized between June 19 and 26, 2010. After this education, project has been finalized with Gala Night which was organized at Mersin Metropolitan Municipality Congress and Exhibition Hall.



This project has been supported by Mersin Governorship, Mersin Metropolitan Municipality Chairmanship, and Provincial Directorate of Health, Provincial Directorate for National Education and Mersin Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation. Aim of the project was to educate total 126 students (13-15 ages). MIP volunteer employees were educated by TIKAV in order to educate the adults in the villages. Additionally, aim was to reach total 7560 people.



Within the context of "New Wine in Old Bottles" project, Computer-Literacy, sport-drama, self carehygiene, first-aid, balanced-nutrition, infectious diseases and dental care has been given to the students by TIKAV, Provincial Directorate for National Education and MIP employees. This project has been started in January with 40 students from 21 villages in the center of Mersin for 1 week. In June 19-26, 35 students from Mersin villages have been educated in Mersin Öğretmenevi.

At the end of 1 week training, students, who were trained in June, presented pon pon dance, theatre, folk dance, choirs and rhythm shows at Mersin Metropolitan Municipality Congress and Exhibition Hall last Saturday.



On behalf of Mersin Governorship, Mersin Deputy Governor Kadir Okatan , TIKAV Deputy Chairman Sultan Yılmaz, MIP General Manager John Phillips and MIP authorities, volunteers and employees participated Gala Night. Students who were educated both in January and June, their families and headmen of the villages participated to this

night.
